Motion by Whiddon 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ellis to dispense with the reading of the minutes of previous meeting and to adopt them as printed, as well as the current financials and budget to actual report as printed. Motion passed.

Motion was made by Ellis 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hyatt to adopt Resolution No. 03-2019 requesting the Police Jury's assistance during the month of February 2019 in pot-hole repair inside the city limits and boom-mowing on all streets and specific pot hole repair on Martin Street. Motion Passed.

Motion was made by Hyatt 2<sup>nd</sup> by Whiddon to adopt Resolution No. 04-2019 appointing Greg Self as Fire District Representative for Hornbeck. Motion Passed.

Motion was made by Whiddon 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ellis to adopt Resolution No. 05-2019 to put in an application with Louisiana Parks and Recreation for the building of a playground area on the Town of Hornbeck property that sits at the corner of Ivy Street, Gillham Street, and Daisy Street. Motion Passed.



Motion was made by Ellis 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hyatt to extend our gas line to the second building at the industrial park in Leesville. Motion Passed.


Jody Browning addressed the council with the need for a small side by side off road vehicle to help keep the streets cleaned and would be used for pot-hole repairs as well. The vehicle would be safer, easier, and quicker to get stuff done. He presented the council with three quotes which are as follows: Sawgie Bottom Outdoor Power Sports, \$9086.50; Louisiana Power Sports, \$9,462.50; and Performance Powersports, \$9,803.50. Motion was made by Hyatt 2<sup>nd</sup> by Whiddon to accept the lowest quote Sawgie Bottom Outdoor Power Sports. Motion Passed.
